1. Student of African Ancestry (African, African American, and African-Caribbean) who is a Suffolk County high school senior at a public High School may apply for the scholarship.
2. Scholarship applicants must have GPA of 3.0 or better.
3. Scholarship applicants must plan on seeking a Baccalaureate Degree.
4. Applicants are required to submit:
  - a. Completed, signed application
  - b. A letter of recommendation from someone who is familiar with your community service work, for example a teacher, a guidance counselor or community leader.
  - c. Current, official transcript
  - d. Typed essay (minimum of 500 words) **Topic: “What Community Service means to me”.**
5. **Application must be received by 11:59p on April 1, 2021.**
